Based on Arnold Lobel's well-loved books and featuring a hummable score by Robert and Willie Reale, this whimsical show follows two great friends -- the cheerful, popular Frog and the rather grumpy Toad -- through four, fun-filled seasons.

Changes and New Programming for Fall 2016!

Early Stages (ages 3-4)

Early Stages for ages 3-4 is an informal, once a week, 30 minute creative drama class that takes after the "Mommy and Me" style of toddler activities.

Offered most Thursday mornings, 10:00-10:30 am, starting August 25.

Early Stages (ages 5-6)

Early Stages for ages 5-6 is an 8 week class offered Saturday mornings, paired with once a week rehearsals, ending in a small performance after the last class on October 8, 2016

Players Company

Very similar programming as the previous years, but Players Company is now for ages 7-9. Still 10 weeks of classes, still a fully mounted play in October and March. Plus we're adding the option for Tuesday evening OR Saturday classes!

Ensemble Company

Very similar programming as the previous years, but Ensemble Company is now for ages 10-12. Devising, technical theatre, and regular theatre classes will still be offered—plus the option for Wednesday evening OR Saturday classes!

Teen Company (ages 13-18)

We are now offering two Saturday Teen Company classes, and eliminating the interview/audition. Still 10 weeks of classes, still a fully mounted production in November and April.

Advanced Teen Company (ages 13-18)

We are now offering two Saturday morning Advanced Teen Company classes. Cap is 10 students per class, and students are required to go through a competitive audition and interview. Still 10 weeks of classes, still a fully

mounted production in November and April with the Teen Company.

Teen Drama Club (ages 13-18)

This free club will be available to all Toledo-area teens, regardless of current or prior participation in CTW programs. Teens will meet once a week to devise, research, interview, edit, and ultimately perform an original theatre piece around current issues. This will be a school year-long commitment.

This club will meet on Wednesdays from 7:15-8:30 pm, starting August 24th.

Again, this is a free program but participants will sign a contract of commitment--excessive absences without prior notice are not allowed.
